A. Information You Provide to Us

B. Information We Collect Automatically

C. Information from Third Parties

We may receive data from:

- Payment processors (e.g., PayPal, Stripe) to confirm transactions.
- Analytics providers (e.g., Google Analytics) for website performance tracking.

2. How We Use Your Information

We use your data for the following purposes:

- To provide our tutoring services (e.g., schedule sessions, send lesson reminders).
- To process payments (handled securely by third-party providers).
- To improve user experience (e.g., personalize content, track performance).
- To send marketing communications (only if you opt-in).
- To comply with legal obligations (e.g., tax and financial regulations).
- To protect our platform (e.g., prevent fraud or misuse of services).

We do not sell or rent your personal information to third parties.

3. Legal Basis for Processing Your Data

Under the UK GDPR, we process your personal data based on:

• Contractual necessity – To provide tutoring services.

- Legal obligations To comply with UK financial and legal requirements.
- Legitimate interests To improve our services and security.
- Consent For marketing communications (you can opt-out anytime).

4. Who We Share Your Information With

We may share your data with:

- Payment processors (e.g., PayPal, Stripe) for transactions.
- Website hosting and analytics providers (e.g., Google Analytics, Wix).
- Law enforcement or regulatory authorities (if legally required).

We require third parties to comply with strict data protection standards.

5. How We Protect Your Data

We take security seriously and implement the following measures:
